Avondale Successful Return to Racing

The Avondale Jockey Club this week successfully staged their first meeting at their own racecourse after an absence of two years.

Reports from jockeys, trainers and NZTR National Venue Inspector Garry Foskett were all very positive following the completion of Monday's eight race programme, with Chief Stipendiary Steward Ross Neal confirming that there were no issues with the performance of the Avondale track. Racing was conducted on a Dead 6 surface after overnight and morning showers. A total of 84 horses started with an average of 10.5 runners across the 8 race programme.

Avondale Jockey Club Secretary/Manager John Craig said that the Club was pleased to have been able to get back on track after the planned resumption of racing in April this year had to be delayed to give the track more time to consolidate following an extensive drainage and sand slitting programme had been completed earlier in the year. "As well as making a significant investment in track drainage, the Club has also built a new owners pavilion and undertaken a considerable amount of work to ensure the horse stabling areas are compliant with industry requirements." The Club only opened up their Main members stand building for the meeting, which comfortably accommodated the midweek crowd with on-course turnover of around \$54,000 in line with the Club's expectation for the day.

Craig said that while there had been a few minor management issues on raceday, the Club was generally very pleased with how Monday's meeting went, particularly given that there had not been any racing conducted at the venue for more than two years. Avondale has a further seven midweek licences scheduled this racing season, with their next meeting to be held on Monday 12 November.
