Minimum Stakes \$8,000 at Riccarton Park

The Canterbury Jockey Club has announced that the minimum stake for all races to be held at Riccarton Park Racecourse this season will be \$8,000.

The Club conducts 23 race meetings each year of which one is a Tier 2 Feature Meeting and four are Industry meetings.

This means that the two Maiden races to be run at the Clubs 'Christmas at the Races' twilight meeting on Friday 7 December will now be run for \$8,000 instead of the advertised \$7,000 and the Maiden and Benchmark Rating 65 races at the Industry Meetings on Thursday 31 January, Wednesday 13 February, Thursday 7 March and Thursday 30 May 2013 will all be run for \$8,000.

Six Races, Six Places – More Ways to Win

The TAB will launch an exciting new racing bet – Place6 – on December 8, giving punters a novel way of betting on all New Zealand race meetings and selected overseas feature meetings.

Place6 requires the successful selection of six place-getters in six races. That means there's more ways to win, with hundreds of possible winning combinations in every Place6 bet.



TAB Head of Race Wagering Michael Dore said Place6 was a great addition to the TAB's totalisator race betting stable.

"Place6 has got some nuances that are quite different to other bet types, the best being that there are just so many ways to win it.

"With six races and three place-getters in each race, Place6 offers more than 700 possible winning combinations, provided each leg has three dividend-bearing places.

"Another great aspect is that, for customers who take, say, a couple of runners in some legs and both runners happen to place, then they can actually win the dividend a number of times. So punters will certainly be in for some pleasant surprises."

Another pleasant surprise would be the potential for some sizeable collects with Place6, said Dore.

"Looking at the place pot in the United Kingdom on a very similar product, half the dividends were more than \$150. The average dividend was actually around \$440, so collects could well be a lot more than people might expect."

Dore said Place6 would nicely complement the TAB's Pick6, where punters must have the winners of six selected races.

"For those meetings with a Pick6 the Place6 will be available on the same races – the last six races of the meeting. So if punters are taking a Pick6 then taking a Place6 will be an insurance or concession bet."

Punters will be able to take a Place6 bet from as little as \$1. Percentage betting will be available. Place6 will be available through at all TAB outlets and via all sales channels.

(1) Avondale JC; no equivalent meeting last year; this year there were 7 races.

(2) Canterbury Racing; there were 11 races last year, compared to 10 races this year.

(3) Otaki-Maori RC; there were 9 races last year, compared to 7 races this year.

- (4) Racing Tauranga; the meeting was detrimentally affected by a deterioration in track conditions which resulted in 13 late scratchings.
- (5) Canterbury Racing; there were 11 races last year (which included 1 race carried over from the 2nd day meeting), compared to 9 races this year, with the scheduled 10th race abandoned due to safety concerns with the presence of lightning from a thunderstorm.
- (6) Last year there was a Waipa RC meeting on the Sunday at which there were 9 races.

The largest betting race for the week was the Group 3 NZ Cup on Saturday at Riccarton which turned over (tote + final field) \$970k, up 23.7% on last year's edition of the race, benefiting from two extra starters in the race (18 vs 16 last year) and a Good 3 track as opposed to the Heavy 10 last year.

The Group 1 New Zealand Bloodstock 40th 1000 Guineas on Saturday turned over \$728k, up 59% on last year.

The Group 2 8th Coupland's Bakeries Mile on Wednesday turned over \$525k, up 2.3% on last year.
